For many years, she was a writer and an editor at national food magazines including *Saveur* and *Food & Wine*. She is the winner of a James Beard Journalism award for her magazine writing. Her essays and articles have appeared in the *New York Times*, *The New Republic*, *O: The Oprah Magazine*, *Newsweek*, and many other publications. She has written and co-written a number of cookbooks, including the *New York Times* bestseller *Smokin' with Myron Mixon*, now in its eleventh printing. Alexander has been a regular contributor on the subject of food to NPR programs across the country. She holds a Ph.D. in cultural anthropology from Duke University and a bachelor's degree in journalism from Northwestern University's Medill School of Journalism. She lives in Chapel Hill with her
